

What can you as a parent do, to have a favorable attitude towards your child's classmates and their parents?

Social activities:

- Be Supportive of playgroups
- Ask for help in case of events and functions
- Support the parents-led activities

The tone of the dialogue:

- Be open about what apparently seems difficult.
- Ask for help if you need it, and offer help if others need it
- Speak well of others
- Speak up about your needs

Take children seriously:

- If your child has been in a conflict, it is important to take it seriously and be curious about what the conflict is about = common solution
 - Look at a case from different angles
 - Respect children's diversity
 - While other children may seem impossible, all children need understanding, care, and a feeling of being a part of a community

The school board at Mørkhøj School emphasizes that Mørkhøj School / SFO is a school for everyone - a school with an insight for the individual child, their diversity and differences, and the community that they are a part of.

When you as parents have chosen Mørkhøj School for your child, you also have agreed to engage in the social work around the class. You say yes to the fact that every child's special needs must be met and respected, although it can be difficult. You also accept the fact that your child might go to a class where some kids can have so many difficulties that, once in a while, the class can be affected by it in their daily work. It is respect and openness for what might be different, which makes it possible to create a good atmosphere in the class. This even reduces the risk of someone being left out.

Gladsaxe Municipality has for years worked with inclusion. This means that there must be room for everyone. This diverse group of kids in your child's class, requires that everyone takes responsibility- responsibility to ensure that all thrive going to school. It is the task for the leadership, teachers and educators, children and you as parents.

As parent you are the most important person in the child's life, and your opinion about others influences and has a great impact on how your child thinks about other children. Therefore as parents, you have a crucial role - along with the rest of the school - to create a good atmosphere in your child's class. A class for everyone!
